Human has created many technologies and ideas but these are reactions of creation. Here, the cause is creation and this cause may lead to any positive results and sometimes negative results.

This philosophical causality has many types; they are probabilistic, counterfactual and mechanistic in view. This Law worksin dependency of causality, because the energy will be a variable when mass and force are varied from another. If there is any change inthe motion, there will be a change in the result soresults of the Newton's Third Law is variable as per the strength of the force.A small change in the motion may increase or decrease the result of the objectin the process.A strong powerful cause may chase the person till end to attain the destiny.

According to Hume in An Enquiry Concerning Human Understanding, the hidden power is, When a man says, I have found, in all past instances, such sensible qualities conjoined with such secret powers: And when he says, similar sensible qualities will always be conjoined with similar secret powers; he is not guilty of a tautology, nor are these propositions in any respect the same. You say that the one proposition is an inference from the other. But you must confess that the inference is not intuitive; neither is it demonstrative: Of what nature is it then? To say it is experimental, is begging the question. For all inferences from experience suppose, as their foundation, that the future will resemble the past, and that similar powers will be conjoined with similar sensible qualities (27).

According to Hume,our past life has some secrets and those secretshave some hidden power and secret

energies. This hidden power gives them a strength to handle any situation with robustness. So, people are learning, experiencing things and knowledge through their past life things, which might affect them traumatically in some cases. Hume stated, our past quality experiences are conjoined with our life to be more meaningful. If, there is any change in the moment, there must be severe change in the future so there is no use with those old experiences. The usage of latent power and secret knowledge may become unworthy in the end, so there is no possibility for the clear outcome in the endwith old unnoticed force and energies (Hume, 27).
